Invitation of Applications for the National Awards for Outstanding services in the field of Prevention of Alcoholism and Substance (Drugs) Abuse, 2022.

The National Awards would be given on 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2022, on the occasion of International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking.

Application are invited for the National Awards for the outstanding Services in the Field of Prevention of alcoholism and Substance (Drug) Abuse under each of the following Categories:-

## I. Institutional Category

- a. Best Integrated Rehabilitation Centre for Addicts (IRCA) for Providing rehabilitation services to alcoholics and drugs users.
- b. Best Panchayati Raj or Municipal Body working for Prevention of alcoholism and Substance (drug) abuse.
- c. Best Educational Institution doing outstanding works in awareness generation and Prevention of alcoholism and substance (drug) abuse.
- d. Best Non-profit Institution, other than Serial Number (i), (ii), (iii), with outstanding contribution in Prevention of Alcoholism and Substance (Drug) Abuse.
- e. Best Research or Innovation.
- f. Best Awareness Campaign.

## II. Individual Category

g. Outstanding achievement by an individual.

# I. Procedure for Applications:

- 1. Application can be submitted by organizations, Institution and Persons fulfilling the prescribed criteria. The Application should be in Hindi or English language only. Criteria laid each of the above category of awards and the full details of the Scheme of National Awards, 2022 may be seen at www.socialjustice.nic.in and e-Anudaan portal (https://grants-msje.gov.in/ngo-login) of the Ministry.
- 2. The following agencies or persons are authorized to nominate and recommend eligible institutions or individuals for the Awards:
  - a. Concerned Ministries or Department of the Government of India and their Autonomous Institutions with the approval of the Ministerin-Charge of the Ministry.
  - b. State Government or Union Territory Administrations with the approval of the Concerned Chief Minister or Lt. Governors in Union territory Administrations.
  - c. State Level Coordinating Agencies (SLCAs) working in the field of drug de-addiction within their own jurisdiction
  - d. Members of the National Consultative Committee on De-addiction Rehabilitation (NCCDR)
  - e. Renowned apex Chambers like Federation of Indian Chambers of Chambers of Commerce and Industry, Confederation of Indian Industry, The Associated Chambers of Commerce and Industry of India etc.

### f. Past Awardees

- g. Organizations like University Grants Commission (UGC), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Medical Council of India (MCI), Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS), Universities, Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT), Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS), Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti (NVS), Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), etc and
- h. Collector of the District/District Magistrate in which the Institution or Individual is working.
- i. Commissioner of Commissionerate in which the Institution or



### Individual is Working

- 3. Only nominations or recommendations emanating from Authorized Agencies or Persons, designated for the purpose, supported by adequate justification, shall be considered.
- 4. Applications in the Prescribed proforma should be applied online on the National Awards Portal, Ministry of Home Affairs at https://awards.gov.in/ from the 05<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 to 20<sup>th</sup>May, 2022.
- 5. Application received after the last date and/or not recommended by the prescribed authority/Persons will not be entertained. The applicants, who had applied earlier for National Awards-2020 and 2022, need to send their applications afresh to the Department for consideration for National Awards-2022 at National Awards Portal of MHA.

Note: The applicants who have applied for National Awards -2022 in the form of Hard Copy or soft copy through email till dated 20.04.2022 this year are also required to upload their application on National Awards Portal, Ministry of Home Affairs at https://awards.gov.in/.
