FAQ 1: What is the 3-Month Certificate Course on Drug De-Addiction, Counseling Skills, and Rehabilitation offered by NISD?

Answer:

The 3-Month Certificate Course is a comprehensive training program conducted by the NCDAP division of NISD. It is designed to equip participants with practical knowledge and skills in drug de-addiction, psychosocial counseling, and rehabilitation of individuals affected by substance use disorders. The course includes theoretical sessions, case studies, field visits, and hands-on experience to prepare professionals, social workers, and NGO staff for effective fieldwork in the area of drug abuse prevention and treatment.

FAQ 2: Who can apply for the 3-Month Certificate Course, and what are the eligibility criteria?

The course is open to individuals with a background in social work, psychology, sociology, public health, or any related field. Preference is given to professionals working in NGOs, rehabilitation centers, or government organizations dealing with substance use issues. Fresh graduates interested in building a career in addiction counseling and rehabilitation may also apply. Applicants are expected to have a strong commitment to community service and a passion for working in the social defence sector.

FAQ 3: What is the objective of the One-Day Awareness Generation Program, and who can participate?

Participation is open to all and is especially encouraged for educational institutions and grassroots organizations.

Yes, participants who successfully complete the 3-Month Certificate Course receive an official Certificate from NISD, endorsed by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India. For the One-Day Awareness Generation Programs, participants are also awarded a participation certificate recognizing their involvement and contribution to spreading awareness on drug abuse prevention.
